## Early Payment Discount

A 5% discount will apply to tuition fees if the account is paid in full within 14 days of the invoice date. The discount does not apply to levies or other charges.

## Payment

Tuition fees will be invoiced each term. Fees should be fully paid by the end of each term. Payments can be made by:

- EFTPOS, Cash, or Cheque at the Administration Office
- Direct Deposit to the College Bank Account with the reference "[Surname] Fees".

## **Laptop Hire - Year 11 and 12**

\*The resource levies for Senior Secondary students includes hire of a College supplied laptop. The laptop is for the exclusive use of the student to support their learning.

Laptops are insured. For accidental damage to a laptop families are liable to pay a charge of \$300 for a first incident, increasing to \$400 for a second incident, and \$500 for subsequent incidents. There are no charges for any warranty repairs. For deliberate damage to the laptop, families will be liable to pay the full repair/replacement cost of the laptop.

## **Vocational Education and Training (VET) - Senior Secondary**

Students are expected to pay for their own tools, protective clothing and equipment as necessary.

Students who withdraw from a VET course after the Term 1 deadline and/or exit Grace Christian College before Term 4 in the year they undertake the VET course, will be charged the full tuition fees for the course. VET course fees will vary [i.e. Allied Health Services is approximately \$2,500].

Students that undertake any additional VET courses within an academic year are liable to pay all fees associated with the additional course.
